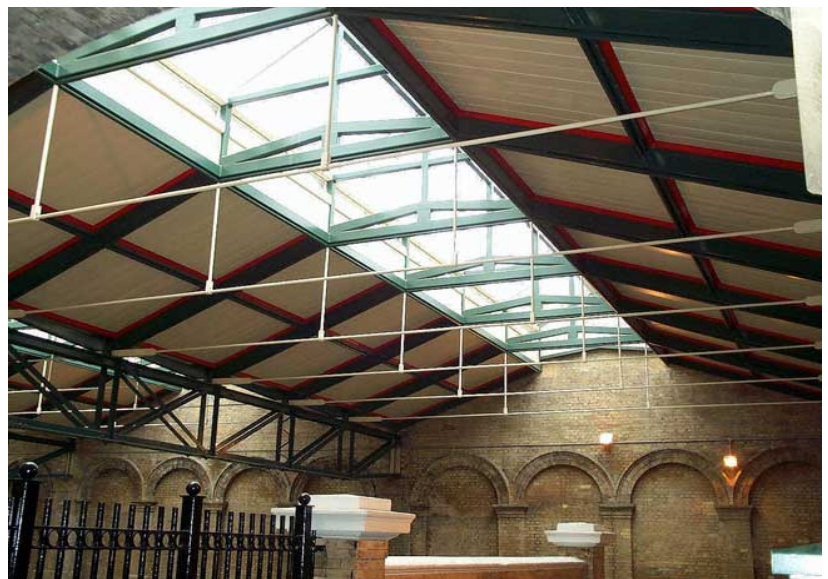

Commencing in 2000, McNealy Brown Limited were awarded the contract for refurbishment works to Crystal Palace station for the renewal of both the roof and Porte Cochere.

Roof - the roof works involved the removal of the existing timber roof trusses and replicating these in steel. The trusses were manufactured at our Sittingbourne works and then installed during a series of T.2 night possessions.

Also included in the roof package were new walkways, access systems and replacement of the North Tower. The section of the building that housed the tower was bombed during the War and subsequently demolished - the new steel structure was installed to return the structure to its former glory.



Porte Cochere - by utilising the original 18th century archived sketches patterns were made for casting of the new columns and filigree infills, the complete Porte Cochere structure being manufactured to match the original.
